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Every designer who's ever accepted an award from the Council of Fashion Designers of America owes a debt to Eleanor Lambert, the legendary publicist who founded the organization in 1962. In *Eleanor Lambert: Still Here*, John A. Tiffany, who worked for her, tells the doyenne's story via the glamorous publicity stunts and press releases she was known for. He recalls Lambert as nothing if not confident. Says Tiffany, "Her famous line was 'I might be wrong, but I just don't see it!'"
