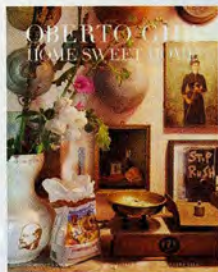

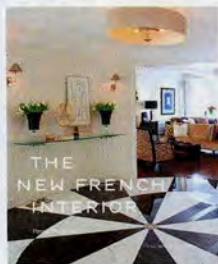
Oberto Gili

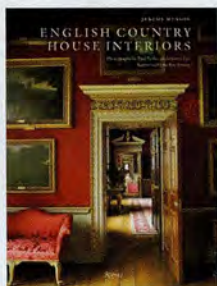


Penny Drue Baird

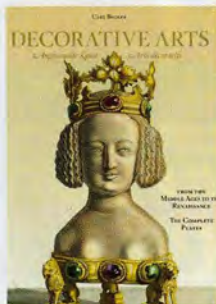
John A. Tiffany *Eleanor Lambert: Still Here*
