ELEANOR LAMBERT: STILL HERE

Calling birds can be a little noisy, but *Eleanor Lambert: Still Here*, author John Tiffany details how NYC's first fashion publicist found her calling. "Eleanor Lambert was the first publicist for artists and fashion designers in NYC ... She found something she loved and she did it. She represented Salvador Dali, Jackson Pollack and many others. She was so good at doing PR for contemporary artists that fashion designers came to her for representation," says Tiffany. "When she started representing American fashion designers, no one cared about American designers, not even *American Vogue*. So, to give these designers a platform, she created Fashion Press Week in 1944, which we now know as NY Fashion Week," continues Tiffany.

Eleanor died at the age of 100 in 2003. *Eleanor Lambert: Still Here* has over 300 illustrations and retails for \$95.
